- **Title must be Times New Roman, first letter of each word is capitalized, 14 pt, bold, centered.**
- **Affiliation Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold, centered.**
- **Author(s) must be Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold, centered.**
- **Main Text: Times New Roman, 12 pt, 1.5 line spacing, 1 cm indent at the beginning of paragraphs.**
- **References: APA format, 10 pt.**

Figures should be placed next to the relevant text in the article. Number figures consecutively by their appearance in the text. A short descriptive title should appear below each figure with

Pasting figures from drawing software is recommended through the paste special function. Do not use outer frames for your figures, fancy backgrounds, grid lines, etc. Keep your figure as simple as possible.

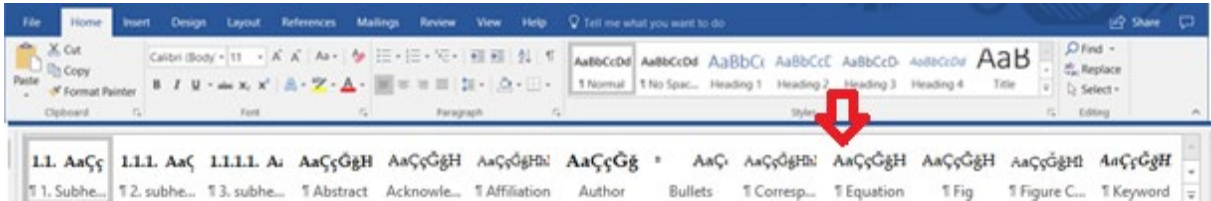


Fig. 1. Styles

When citing in the text more than one paper, separate the references with symbols ";". In the text, show the cited references in chronological order. In the References section show the cited publication in alphabetical order without numbers in the front. Show all the authors. Follow the examples in the references. If you use reference management software (Mendeley or EndNote), you can download and use the output styles prepared for IMPS 2024 from the links, or you can use the APA 7th format.
